

## OSPREY FLY BOX

## SIMPLY BLACK

When camping you often run into sites with many Mosquitoes or Black Flies. One night at home I decided that I would tie a small fly to represent the Black Fly. I tied a few very simple ones and put them away in a fly box and basically forgot about them.

Some time later, I was fishing at Peter Hope Lake with some friends. The fishing was very slow that day. I looked in one of my fly boxes and noticed the Black Flies that I had tied months earlier. I had seen some Black Flies in the air so I decided to put one on. Much to my surprised I caught a nice trout on my first cast. This was followed by several others that afternoon.

It didn't seem to matter whether the fly was on the surface or partially submerged.



## **MATERIALS**



**Hook:** Stealth Barbless Dry Fly #12

Thread: UTC 70 Black

**Body:** Wapsi Antron Sparkle Dubbing

Black Gnat

Hackle: Chinese Neck Hackle Black

## **TYING INSTRUCTIONS**



- 3
- 1. Start the thread on the hook and cover the hook shank to the point of the hook.
- 2. Twist the dubbing on the thread and dub the rear 3/4 of the hook shank.
- 3. Tie in a Chinese Neck hackle feather by the stem and wrap several times around the hook shank then tie off.
- 4. Build a small neat head whip finish and dab with head cement, and just like that its done.
